Background: In April 2023, a brutal war broke out in Sudan, displacing over 5 million people. Hundreds of thousands of refugees fled to Egypt for safety.

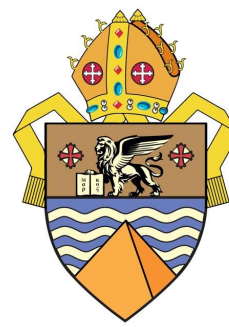
Our Response: The Anglican Church in Egypt has been serving refugees through Christ's love since 1987. Our ministry called Refuge Egypt walks alongside refugees in many ways, from medical care and humanitarian assistance to jobs placement and English classes. We also opened schools, which allow the children to continue their education during their journey in Egypt.

St. Raphael School: Located in a Sudanese neighborhood in the outskirts of Cairo, Egypt, this K-12 school uses the Sudanese curriculum, employs Sudanese teachers and Staff, and allows the students to feel accepted and valued as they learn. After the war, demand for enrollment exploded from 175 to 300, at which point we had to stop accepting students due to our extremely limited space: two floors of a small apartment building.

New Plans: We thank the Lord that the Diocese was able to locate and purchase a new building for St. Raphael to continue serving this community! When the move is complete, we will be free from a bad landlord and have enough space for this growing community. Even more than that, the new building's open spaces will allow for gym class, school assemblies, and for the establishment of a Sudanese church on the weekends—none of which is possible now.

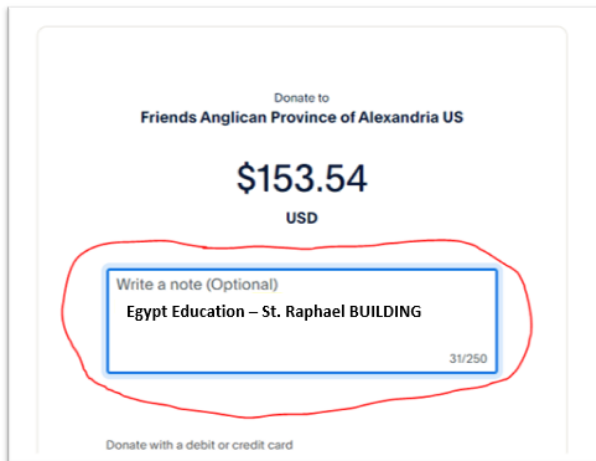

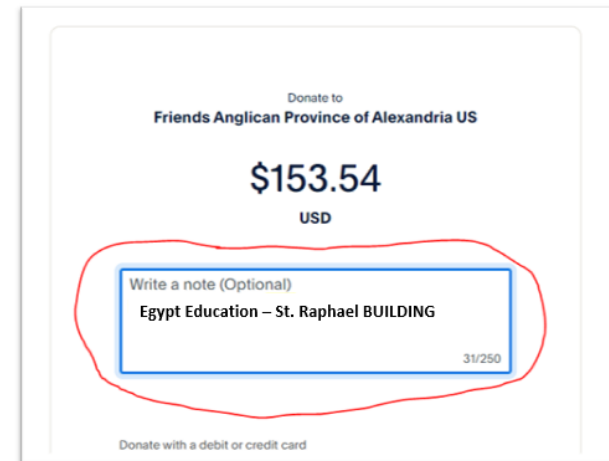
